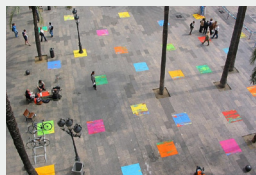

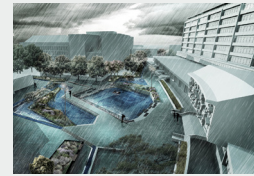

How City Makers co-create the city and ignite social innovation.

The Dutch organisation Pakhuis de Zwijger, a unique cultural organisation which opened its doors in 2006 and has grown to be an independent platform focusing on the role of multi-stakeholders in making our cities sustainable and liveable, organizes Fabrica Ciudad from August 29 until October 28 in Quito. This Urban Factory brings an inspiring programme of lectures, seminars, debates and presentations focusing on social innovation, City Makers' practices and new forms of urban governance. During Habitat III local City Makers will be connected to renowned international speakers and international delegacies.

This unique initiative matches perfectly with the world's contribution during Habitat III, since it is based on the belief that liveable, inclusive, prosperous and sustainable cities are a result of the joint efforts of civil society organisations, public authorities, knowledge institutions, pioneering City Makers and businesses.

Prior to the Habitat III conference, six inspiring sessions have already taken place. All of the upcoming events will take place during the Habitat III conference in Centro Cultural Benjamín Carrión at Jorge Washington E2-42 y Ulpiano Páez, Quito, unless stated otherwise.

Fabrica Ciudad is part of the Habitat III Village project the Ruta de la Experiencia, which has been fabricated by the Human Cities Coalition. The Human Cities Coalition is a public-private partnership of Dutch organizations from government, NGOs and business that want to make a positive difference in the world's cities, of which AkzoNobel is the founding partner. The practical interventions in the Ruta - such as greening, lighting and painting - visualize the Human Cities Coalition's approach to create sustainable improvement of cities' liveability for all. It is demand-driven, strengthens existing citizens' initiatives and unites relevant parties from private sector, government and civil society to cooperate in bringing tangible solutions to urban challenges.
